ABOUT US



We take care of sick and injured people in South Australia.



In an emergency you call 000.



If you are sick or injured an ambulance will come to you.



The Paramedics or SAAS Volunteers in the ambulance will will take care of you and take you to hospital.

A **Paramedic** is a person who looks after you in an emergency.

WHAT IS AMBULANCE COVER?



You have to pay us after an ambulance comes to help you.

It can cost a lot of money.



If you have **Ambulance Cover** you do not have to pay for the ambulance.

Ambulance Cover is a fee that means you do not have to pay for the ambulance every time you call one.

A **fee** is when you pay one time so you can use something many times.



With Ambulance Cover you can call an ambulance as many times as you need.



Ambulance Cover can save you lots of money.

HOW DO I GET AMBULANCE COVER?



You can get Ambulance Cover by paying us a fee.



You have to pay the fee every year to always have Ambulance Cover.



You can pay for yourself and your family.


Family means people who you live with are related to you like mothers, fathers, daughters and sons.



WHAT ARE THE TYPES OF AMBULANCE COVER?



You pay different prices for different kinds of Ambulance Cover.



- Standard
- Standard Plus

Standard means you are covered for using an ambulance for free in South Australia.

Standard Plus means you are covered for using an ambulance for free anywhere in Australia.



You can get Ambulance Cover for:

- yourself
- you and your family



The fee is lower if you are a pensioner.

A **pensioner** is someone who can get cheaper healthcare, medicines and discounts.

WHAT ARE THE AMBULANCE COVER FEES?



These are the fees from 1 August 2023 to 31 July 2024.

You choose what kind of Ambulance Cover you want.



Standard:

- one person \$96.50
- family \$192
- one pensioner \$58
- family pensioner \$115



Standard plus:

- one person \$114
- family \$226.75
- one pensioner \$75.50
- family pensioner \$149.75

You pay the fee once a year.

HOW DO I PAY FOR AMBULANCE COVER?



There are 4 ways you can pay the fees.
