

# Advertising and Proposed Intakes

- The vacancy is open in April 2025 for ~ two weeks
- Set up a job alert on SA Health Career site or I Work for SA to be notified when the job goes live
- Late applications will not be accepted under any circumstances
- Internship will be advertised as a pool
- Offers will be made based on organisational need
- Proposed intake dates :
  - 26 January 2026
  - 01 June 2026
  - 28 September 2026
- If you are unable to accept the offer made, you may not be made a further offer
- Remaining recommended candidates not made an offer will be placed in the recruitment pool for a period of 12 months and be contacted should an internship opportunity arise

#### You are required to supply three referees:

- Qualified Paramedic with an Ambulance service directly involved in your clinical placements and or development who can accurately comment on your abilities whilst undertaking placements as part of your studies,
- a Line Manager or Team Leader within an Ambulance service who can comment on your abilities whilst undertaking placements as part of your studies
- a Line Manager or Supervisor in any other professional work or volunteering capacity
