You can ask for help to read this document.

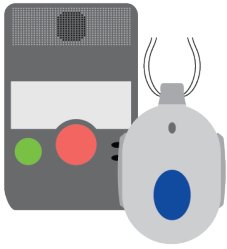
A friend, family member or support person may be able to help you.

WHAT IS CALL DIRECT CLOSURE?



You have a Call Direct personal alert system in your home.
The system includes a unit and pendant.



The Telstra 3G Network is closing on 30 June 2024.
Call Direct units and pendants need the 3G Network to work.



From 1 July 2024 the Call Direct System will not work.
We recommend you switch to another medical alert provider
before this date.



When your new alert system is installed, you need to cancel your
Call Direct membership.
To cancel your membership, you need to call **1800 512 213** during
business hours.



We will send you a plastic bag to put the unit and pendant in.
You can drop the bag to any Australia Post Office and they will send it
back to us. There will be no cost to you.



From 1 March 2024, our Call Direct support will change:

- Repairs to the unit or pendant will only be during business hours.
- We will not reinstall your unit, pendant or key box if you move house.
- If you need to change your personal or medical condition details, you must call us on **1800 512 213**.
